2018 Details

Venue: Oasis Swim Centre, Wagga on Wednesday 21st February. First event commences at **9:30am**.

Closing Date for Entries: 9:00am Wednesday 14th February 2018.

COSTS:

- **Pool Entry Fees: \$4.00** for Competitors, and **\$2.50** for a spectator's passout. *(Could each school contact the Oasis (to confirm how they wish to pay competitors entry fees.)*
- **Deanery Levy: \$8.00** per competitor.
- **Other Costs** as necessary for your school: eg, Bus travel

TIME:

8:30am– 9:10 am

Schools arrive and set up.

Students may have a short warm up if they need to.

NOTE: Only Lanes 0 and 9 are for practicing **dive starts**.

Lanes 1 –8 are for swimming only. **THERE ARE TO BE NO DIVE ENTRIES IN THESE LANES** for safety reasons. **Teachers are to supervise their students.**

9:10 am

The pool is to be cleared and all students return to their school areas ready to swim.

9:15 am

Host School (Coolamon) will welcome everyone with a short Prayer.

9:20 am Marshall for the first event. All students are to move promptly to the marshalling area at the deep end of the pool when their event is called.

9:30 am First Event to commence.

There will be no official recess/lunch breaks as students will be expected to eat/drink between their events. The Oasis Swim Centre canteen will remain open during the day. Please remind students to stay under shade areas, wear their school shirt and their school hat and re-apply sunscreen between their events.

The officials numbers allow for two timekeepers on each lane. If you have a parent who is experienced in a particular area, please advise me. **Please have officials organised prior to the day.**

Relay entry is one team per event per school.

Ribbons will be given to the first three (3) places in each **event**.
