PROCESS FOR SELECTION FOR POLDING/MACKILLOP TEAMS

All students must progress through school, region, Diocese.

Polding and MacKillop compete in a combined swimming championship where each association conducts their championships concurrently. Each Diocese is invited to send a team of athletes (Parramatta & Sydney send regional teams).

Selections for Polding and MacKillop are based on results of each event. Multi Class events are included in these championships.

PLEASE NOTE : This Championship is conducted under the ONE START rule.

POOL ENTRY

The cost of entry for swimmers and their families is included in the Diocesan fee charged.

PROGRAM

Entry to the pool and warm up starts at 8am - no competitor will be admitted BEFORE 7:30am. First events will be marshalled at 8:30am.

First events will commence at 8:45am sharp. Program times subject to change.

To be considered for selection in the NSWPSA state team for participation at all School Sport Australia 12 Years & Under championships: Students must be turning between the ages of 10 and 12 in the year of competition i.e. Students turning the ages of 8, 9 and 13 in the year of competition are not eligible for NSWPSA State selection.

POLDING & MACKILLOP TEAM SELECTIONS

ALL students coming to the NSWCPS Polding and MacKillop Swimming Championships MUST be registered online before attending. 1st, 2nd & 3rd place will progress to NSW PSSA Swimming Championships on 11th & 12th April at SOPAC representing Polding or MacKillop.

Team registration & consent, payment of levies & uniform to be completed at NSWCPS trials. Computers will be available to complete the registration and payment through the website. Please bring you log in details with you.

Optional Uniform will be available for purchase.

PARKING

This will be available in P2 or, if full, in additional parking stations as directed by signs in the Aquatic Centre precinct. The cost of parking is \$15 per day flat rate. You must get your ticket validated.

SWIMMING PSSA **ONE START RULE**

The NSW PSSA has introduced the “**One Start Rule**” for their State Championships.

This means that if there is a **False Start** all swimmers swim the race and the swimmer who broke at the beginning will be told of their “**disqualification**” at the end of the race.

This brings the PSSA into line with Swim NSW.

The MacKillop and Polding carnivals will be swum under the same rule.

To this end it is suggested that we have the same rule at the **DIOCESAN CARNIVAL**.

School carnivals can be swum by whatever rulings each school deem fit as some carnivals are more “formal” than others.

As Deanery Carnivals are also run on a semi formal basis it is suggested that the old two start rule can even stay in use but once we get to the Diocesan Carnival students should be getting ready for the more “formal” carnival further on.
